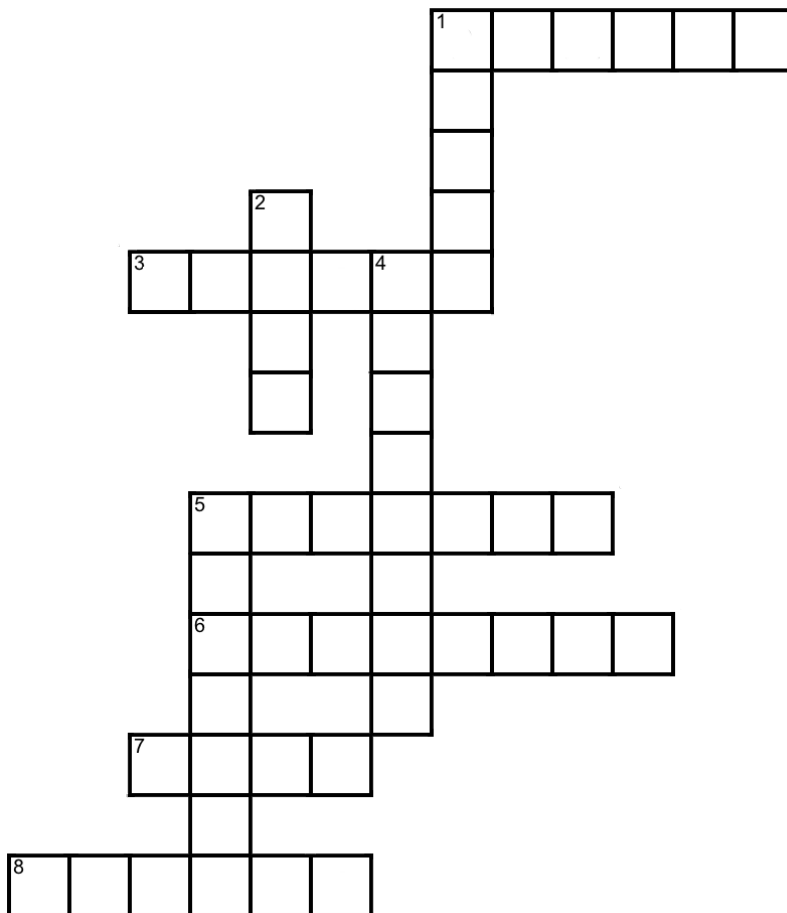


Safety First! Crossword Puzzle
