How to Use This Program

Photocopy this teacher's guide and the three activity sheets before putting the poster on display in your classroom. Use the poster to introduce *Trollhunters* and as a visual focal point throughout the lessons.

Activity 1 - Character

Meet the Team that Saves the World (after Gym Class)

Start by asking students to brainstorm what they think makes them want to know how a story ends: An exciting plot? An emotional ending? A story with a lot of humor? Point out that no matter how interesting the plot or how funny the dialogue, readers or viewers have to care about the characters.

Explain that in most stories, the main characters complement each other, each with his or her own weaknesses and strengths.

Ask students to list some common character traits, and write them on the board or on a large piece of paper. Talk about how each trait can help the reader identify more with the character. When finished, tell the students that today they are going to look at some of the main characters in *Trollhunters* and decide how each character's unique traits could help the team in tricky situations. Refer to the poster and discuss each character. Ask the students to think about their own character traits and how those traits could benefit Jim and his friends. Then have them complete the activity sheet.

Activity 2 - Setting

What Lies Beneath Your Town?

Ask students to come up with ideas about what else is important in storytelling besides the characters. Explain that a story's setting creates a mood and gives clues about the characters and what might happen in the story. For example, a sullen and dangerous character would probably not live in a rainbow-colored house, but might instead lurk under a shadow-filled bridge.

A shadowy bridge plays an important part in *Trollhunters*, where it acts as a portal through which the evil Gumm-Gumms — who live in the Darklands — can invade our world. *Trollhunters* also features other imaginative settings, such as

the colorful Heartstone Trollmarket, which lies beneath the small, peaceful town of Arcadia, and Arcadia Oaks High School, where Jim's history teacher happens to be a changing spy! Refer to the poster so the students can get a good idea of what the settings in *Trollhunters* look like.

Begin Part 1 of the activity by asking students to think about where they live. What makes the "setting" of their lives special? Pass out the activity sheet, and have the students complete the graphic organizer using their own hometown as a reference. Have them think about peaceful areas of their town and some places that seem like they could be occupied by fantastical creatures such as those in *Trollhunters*. Then ask them to imagine an amazing, fantastical world beneath their hometown. Have them use the graphic organizer again to brainstorm a setting for magical creatures.

For Part 2 of the activity, have students expand on their brainstorming to write a description of their *Trollhunters*-like setting. What does the world feel, smell, and look like? Is it a welcoming place, and where is the exit to the world of humans above?

Activity 3 - Plot

Escape from the Darklands!

Tell students that now they will be learning about plot. The plot drives the action and serves as a map of the most important events. In every great story, the plot rises, climaxes, falls, and resolves.

At the end of Season 1 of *Trollhunters*, Jim enters the Darklands, leaving his Trollhunter team behind in an effort to protect them. Tell the students that this plot device is sometimes called a *cliffhanger* — the point where the audience is left in suspense. Cliffhangers usually happen near or at the climax, and they make the audience want to keep reading or watching.

Tell students that in Season 2 of *Trollhunters*, Jim fights alone and becomes trapped in the Darklands. Based on what they know about the characters, what else do the students think might happen in Season 2? Will the evil Gunmar escape into our world? Will Jim's friends be able to find him?

Pass out the activity sheet. Ask students to pretend they are screenwriters and that they need to create a story arc for Season 2. Tell them to use their imagination and knowledge of the characters to complete the graphic on the sheet.

Then have students write a short story using their plot for Season 2. Tell them to include themselves as a valuable member of the Trollhunters team!

Jim Lake, Jr.: An average high school student, Jim yearns for adventure. He gets that and more when he becomes the first human protector of a secret world of Trolls living beneath his hometown. Jim is brave, loyal, and a talented cook whose skills with a knife lend themselves to sword fighting.



Claire: Intelligent, talented, and a martial arts expert, she's the voice of reason and the brains behind many of the team's plans.



Blinky: Jim's chief Troll advisor. With lots of enthusiasm, he's wise and has a heart of gold.

- Gunmar discovers Jim's friends are in the Darklands and both the Trollhunters and Gunmar try to escape.




- Jim and friends are at detention when Draal (possessed by Gunmar) arrives and Jim is arrested.
