Contest Topic: **Help Prevent Drunk and Drugged Driving**

TO ENTER Students ages 13 to 19 in grades 6-12 must create a storyboard or written script on 8.5 x 11-inch paper for a 30-second public service announcement (PSA) video to help prevent drunk and drugged driving. (Students may address one topic or both topics.)

Judging criteria: 1) originality and creativity (10 points); 2) PSA concept (10 points); 3) clarity of message (10 points); and 4) quality of writing (5 points)

Only individual entries will be accepted. **NO GROUP ENTRIES.** No videos or discs. A student's teacher or parent/legal guardian can submit the student's entry. Entries can be submitted by mail or uploaded at ymiclassroom.com/drive2life. Teachers may mail entries in one envelope for the class.
