How to Use This Program



Activity 1 Road Trip!

Read the above synopsis of *The Addams Family 2* to your students. Before distributing the activity sheet, ask students if they've ever taken a family road trip and, if so, where they traveled. Explain that in this activity, students will learn fun facts about several real-world tourist destinations that The Addams Family visits — some that students may be familiar with and some that are very spooky. Distribute the activity sheet and have students complete it on their own or with a partner.

Answers: 1. Grand Canyon; 2. Las Vegas; 3. Niagara Falls; 4. Sleepy Hollow; 5. Cities of the Dead; 6. Death Valley

Extension: Show the classroom poster and explain that when planning a road trip, people often choose stops that are visually interesting and have historical significance. Using these criteria, ask students to brainstorm suggested road trip destinations and list them on the poster.

Activity 2 Story Time!

Start this activity by reviewing different parts of speech (noun, adjective, verb, etc.) and giving a few examples for reference. Distribute the activity sheet. Explain how the activity's fill-in-the-blanks structure works and that students will be stepping into the perspective of Wednesday Addams, who is whip-smart, with a dry sense of humor and a fondness for the grotesque. Remind them that the words they choose should reflect The Addams Family's appreciation of all things spooky, weird, crawly, slimy, and scary!

Activity 3
Snap Your Fingers!

Explain that a character trait describes an aspect of someone's personality. Point out that everyone has their own set of traits that make them unique. Remind students that character traits are often shown as descriptive adjectives and give a few examples. Distribute the activity sheet and have students complete Part 1 only.

Answers: Part 1: 1. clever (smart); 2. funny (silly); 3. pesky (annoying); 4. helpful (kind)

To introduce Part 2, play or read aloud *The* Addams Family theme song. Ask students to listen for the words used to describe the family. Afterward, ask them to write down words to describe traits of their own family. Next, review the rhyme scheme and format of the song. Then guide students to use their lists of character traits and other descriptive vocabulary to rewrite The Addams Family theme song so it describes their own family. Remind students that The Addams Family enjoys being kooky. Encourage kids to write their own upbeat, fun family song. As a follow-up, invite students to film a short video of their family singing and/or dancing along to the song they created.

Extension: Use the following prompts to have students create a two-column comparison chart: Which traits do your family members share? Which traits are different? (Examples: interests and hobbies; favorites) Have students use their charts to discuss how our differences make us each unique and at the same time help us work together as a team or family.

Activity 4 Meet the "Manimal"!

Distribute the activity sheet. As a warm-up, ask students to brainstorm abilities that are unique to humans. (Examples: ability to speak, ability to make and use tools, etc.) Divide the class into teams and have them research unusual animal abilities, just as Wednesday does for her science fair experiment. As they work on the activity, remind them that scientists highly value the ability to think outside the box when considering new possibilities!

Extension: Hold a gallery walk "science fair" for students to share their work with their classmates. Have students use sticky notes to leave constructive comments on their classmates' designs.
