

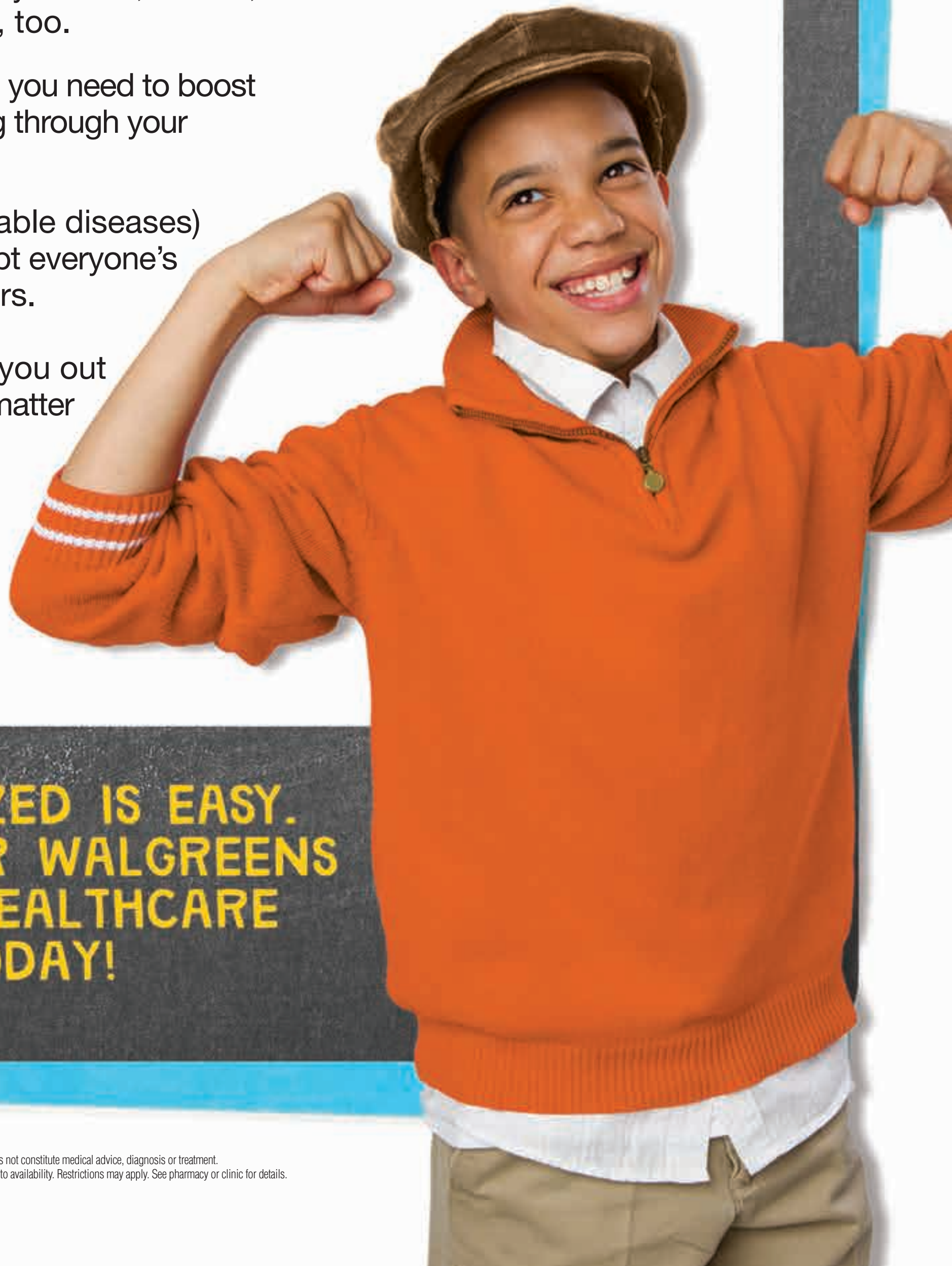
GET YOUR TDAP VACCINE BY OCTOBER 15!

This year, the Illinois State Board of Education requires that all students in grades 6-12 be immunized for Tdap — tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (or whooping cough) — by October 15, 2013, or you will be subject to exclusion from school.

Health officials also recommend that middle and high school students be immunized against the flu, HPV infection, and meningococcal disease. Why?
