Streetcar Safety— It's All About You!

Safe Kids Know—and Follow—the Rules

- 1. LOOK both ways and LISTEN for the streetcar before you step into the crosswalk. Streetcars can come from either direction and they can be very quiet.
- 2. Never walk in front of a moving streetcar.
- **3.** Only cross the streetcar tracks at a crosswalk when the WALK signal is on.
- **4.** Never walk, run, or play along the streetcar tracks.

5. Never try to climb the poles or touch the wires around the streetcar tracks. The wires are electrified.

6. Don't ride your bike or skateboard across the streetcar tracks; walk or carry it across. Use the two-way bike lanes on G and I streets as a safe alternative route.

7. Never grab the back of a streetcar to be pulled along on your bike or skateboard.

8. Never run to catch a streetcar or try to board if it is moving. Streetcars will only pick up or let off passengers at designated stops.

9. Watch your step getting on and off the streetcar.

10. Tell the operator if there is an emergency.
