

## How to Use This Program

Make copies of this teacher's guide, the activity sheets, and the parent letter before putting the poster on display in your classroom. Use the poster as a visual aid and learning tool for each activity. Write your classroom guidelines in the "teamwork tips" area, and use it to remind children that good friends have fun when they are kind to each other and work together as a team, just like Cory and his friends! Send home copies of the letter for parents/guardians to extend the learning adventures.

### Activity 1

#### 1, 2, 3, Come Play with Me!

In this activity, the children will practice social-emotional skills, self-expression, and kindness as they work and play together as a team. Tell the children that you are going to talk about teamwork, which means people working together. Explain that sometimes people work together to get a job done, like when firefighters work together to put out a fire. People also work together to learn and have fun, just like Cory and his friends! Use the poster as a visual aid to introduce Cory and the other characters. Ask the

children to imagine what Cory might enjoy doing with his friends. Then ask the children to share examples of teamwork in their own lives and at school. For example, they might work together when they build a block tower, or to clean up after snack time.

Tell the children that an important part of teamwork is being kind to each other. It's also important that everyone helps! Lead a role-playing activity to demonstrate teamwork behaviors or tips, such as sharing, taking turns, using kind words, listening, and helping each other. Refer to the poster for this activity.

Pass out the activity sheet and go over the directions. Use Part 1 to introduce the characters and Part 2 to brainstorm teamwork activities children would do if Cory and his friends came to visit. Then, have the children share their pictures and ideas.

### Activity 2

#### Zoom Zoom! Find the Shapes

Cory and his family live in Bumperton Hills, a beautiful land of many shapes and textures. Hilltops are round, trees have heart-shaped leaves, and stars hang from doorways. Although the shapes are different, together they make Bumperton Hills a colorful, special place to live. In this activity, students will search for shapes and identify their differences, and learn that their differences make them special.

Ask the children to look at the poster. Review the characters' names, and then ask students to find shapes in the poster. As they identify shapes, talk about how the shapes are alike or different. How many sides do they have? How many corners? Do they have straight or curved edges? Then tell the children that it's time to see how many different shapes they can find in the room. Give them five minutes to "zoom around the room" to find as many shapes as they can.

Have the children share the shapes they found and describe how the shapes are different from each other. Direct their attention back to the poster, and ask the children to identify how Cory and his friends are different from one another. Explain that because they are different, Cory and his friends learn from each other, just like we do.

Pass out the activity sheet. As students complete the sheet, discuss how the students are different from each other (names, favorite colors, things they like to do/eat, etc.), and how they can learn from each other because of their differences.




