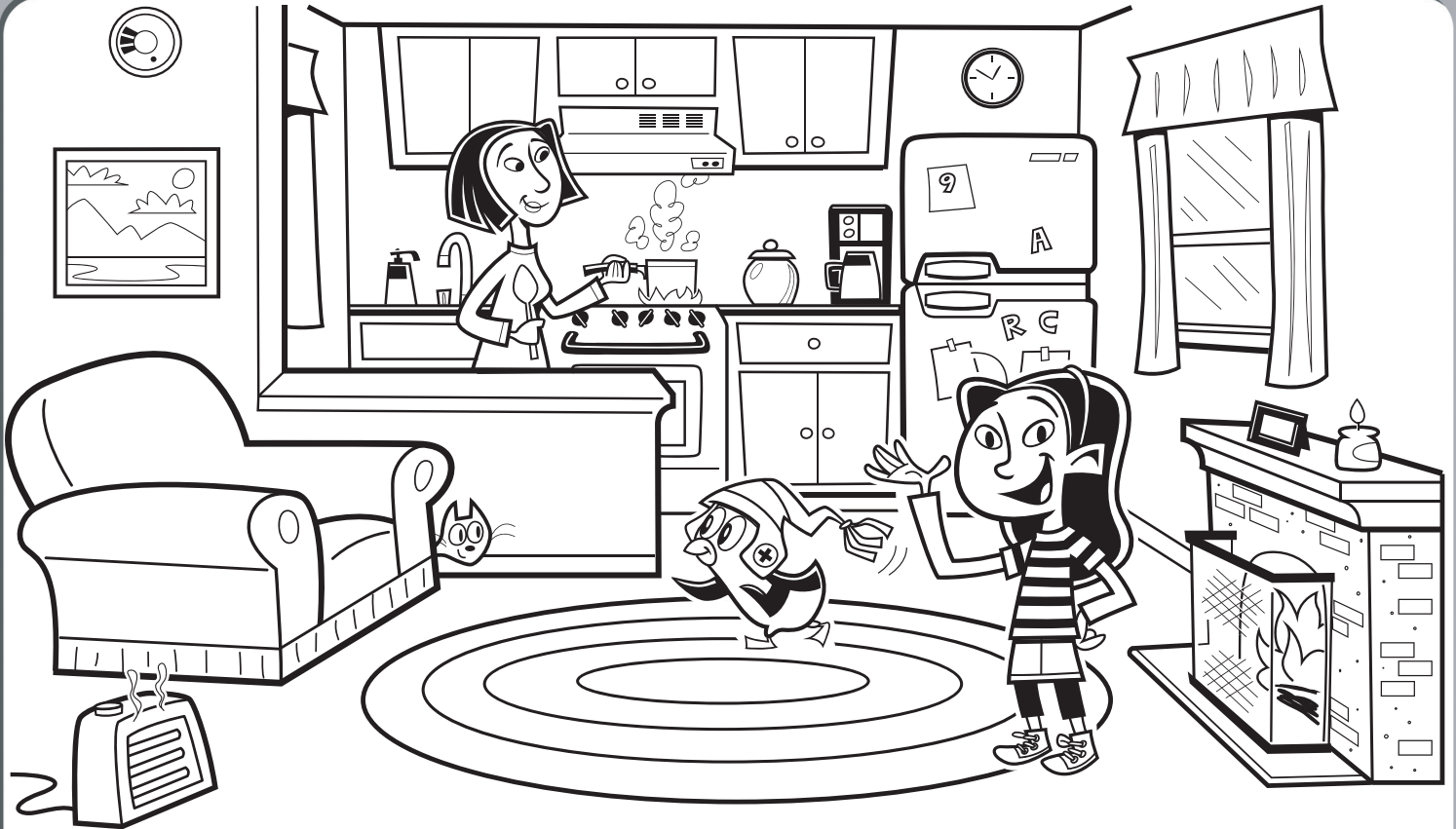




Keep Mia's Home Fire-Safe!
