How to Use the Program

This program can be used by teachers, parents, and caregivers. Make photocopies of the two activity sheets to use in class, or email them to families to use at home, along with the family takehome letter. In class, read each activity aloud while pointing to each word as you read it. Students will need crayons and dice for the activities.

ACTIVITY 1 Baby Shark's Home

Before kids take a deep dive into their underwater adventures with Baby Shark, William, Vola, Goldie, Chucks, and Hank, they'll first learn more about the

show's setting - the ocean. In this activity, children will practice identifying animals and objects that live in underwater habitats as they explore Carnivore Cove.

First, ask students to look around the classroom. What objects do they see? Now ask them to close their eyes and picture the ocean. What objects do they think of? Hand out the activity sheet and ask them which objects they see on the sheet that belong in the ocean and which do not. Model an object that belongs by circling it and an object that does not by putting an X on it. Have students complete the sheet independently with your support by coloring the ocean scene and the items that belong.

As an extension, take a field trip to the library to select books about the ocean and set up an underwater reading nook with a blue blanket or pillows. Or take a virtual trip to an aquarium and explore photos of sea life. Have students draw pictures of what they see to create a class book of fin-tastic favorite ocean animals and plants.

ACTIVITY 2 Shake Your Fins and Dance

Carnivore Cove is full of adventure, friendship, and sonas. Each episode of **Baby**

Shark's Big Show!


has a new song to share and sing. In this activity, the classroom can become an underwater dance floor where children make up their own dance while learning about counting.

To begin the activity, ask for student volunteers to sing a favorite song or show a favorite dance move. Next, hand out the activity sheet. Model rolling the dice. Count the dots on the die by pointing to each dot with a finger. Match the face of the die and number to the moves on the activity sheet. Then model the dance move! Put children in pairs or groups to roll the die to find out which fantastic fin moves they will use in their dance. Have groups take turns shaking and sharing their dance with the class while they sing the Baby Shark's Big Show! theme song (found at https://youtu.be/l0yX8RyYNlc).

For even more fin-nomenal dances, encourage students to roll the die more than once to create a pattern of movements. Cut out extra pictures of the dance moves from the activity sheet and let students glue the moves to sentence strips. Post them in the dramatic play area with ocean puppets or pictures of laminated ocean animals glued to large popsicle sticks for future creative play.


