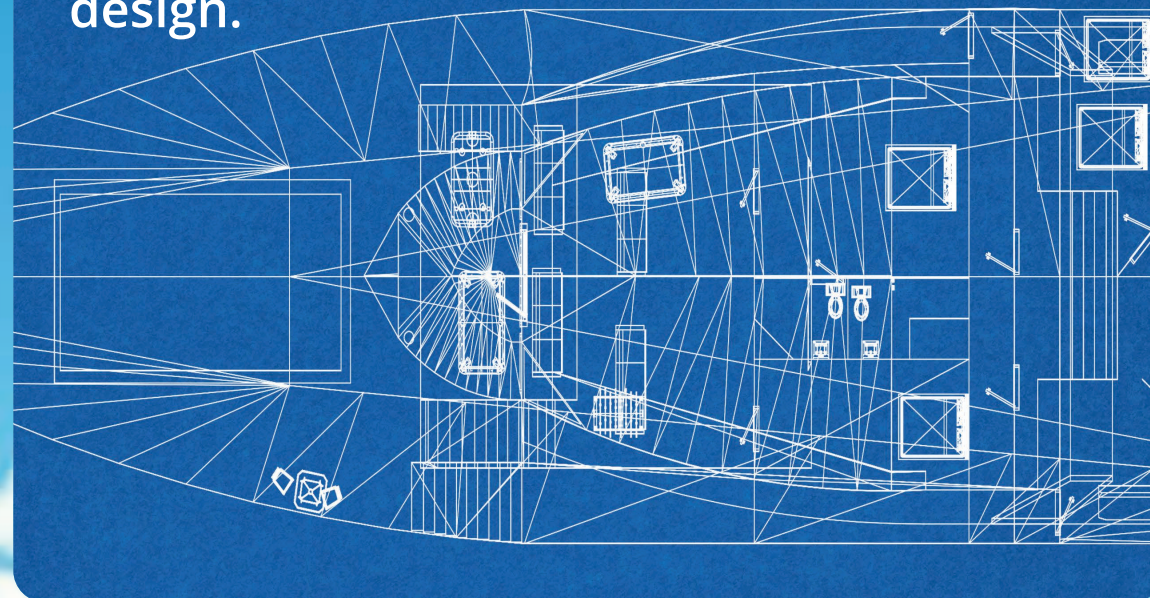
Materials Specialist

Develops and implements strategies to optimize shipping routes and reduce the carbon footprint of the maritime industry.



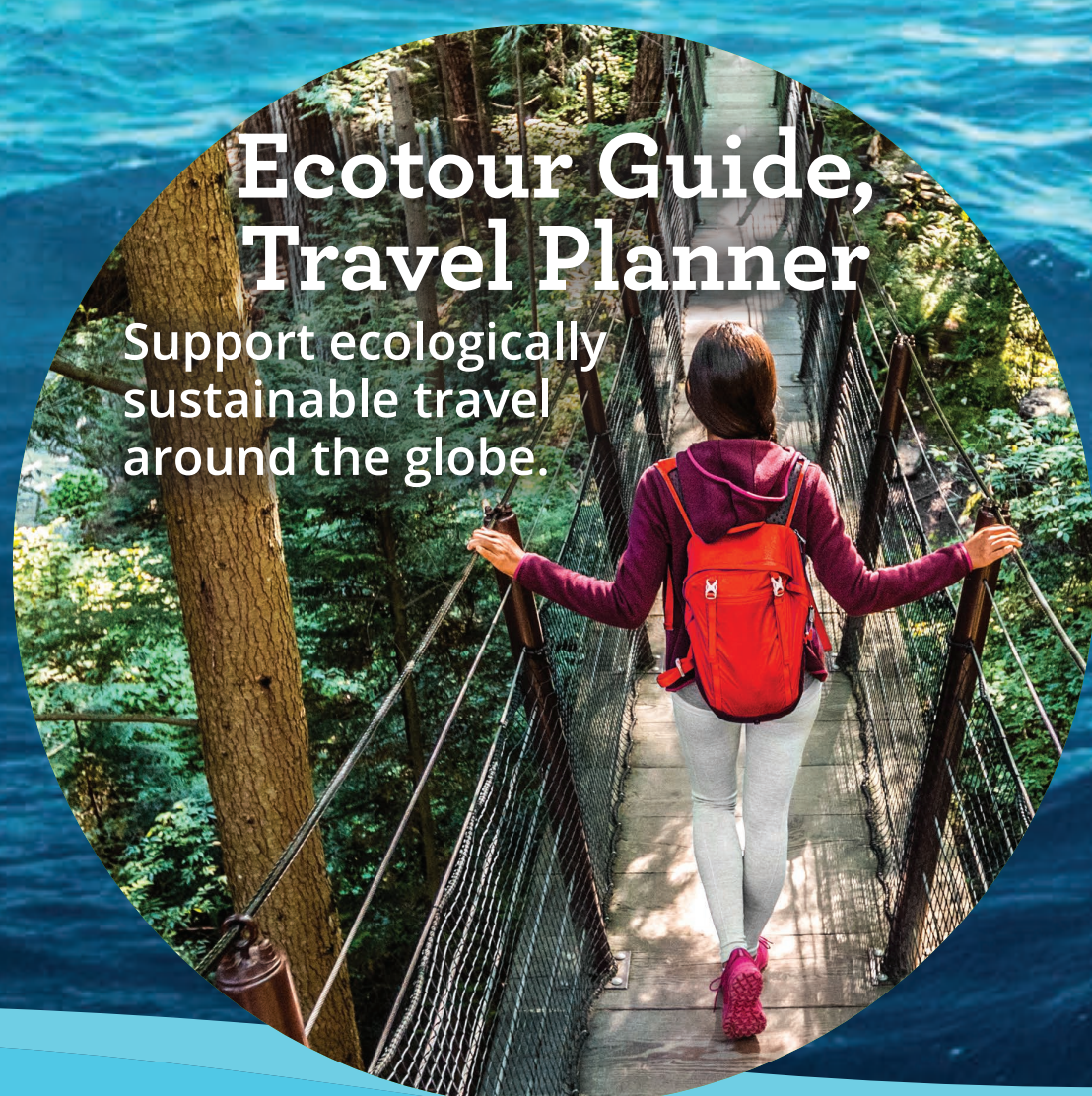
Environmental Analyst

Ensures a ship complies with environmental regulations and standards.



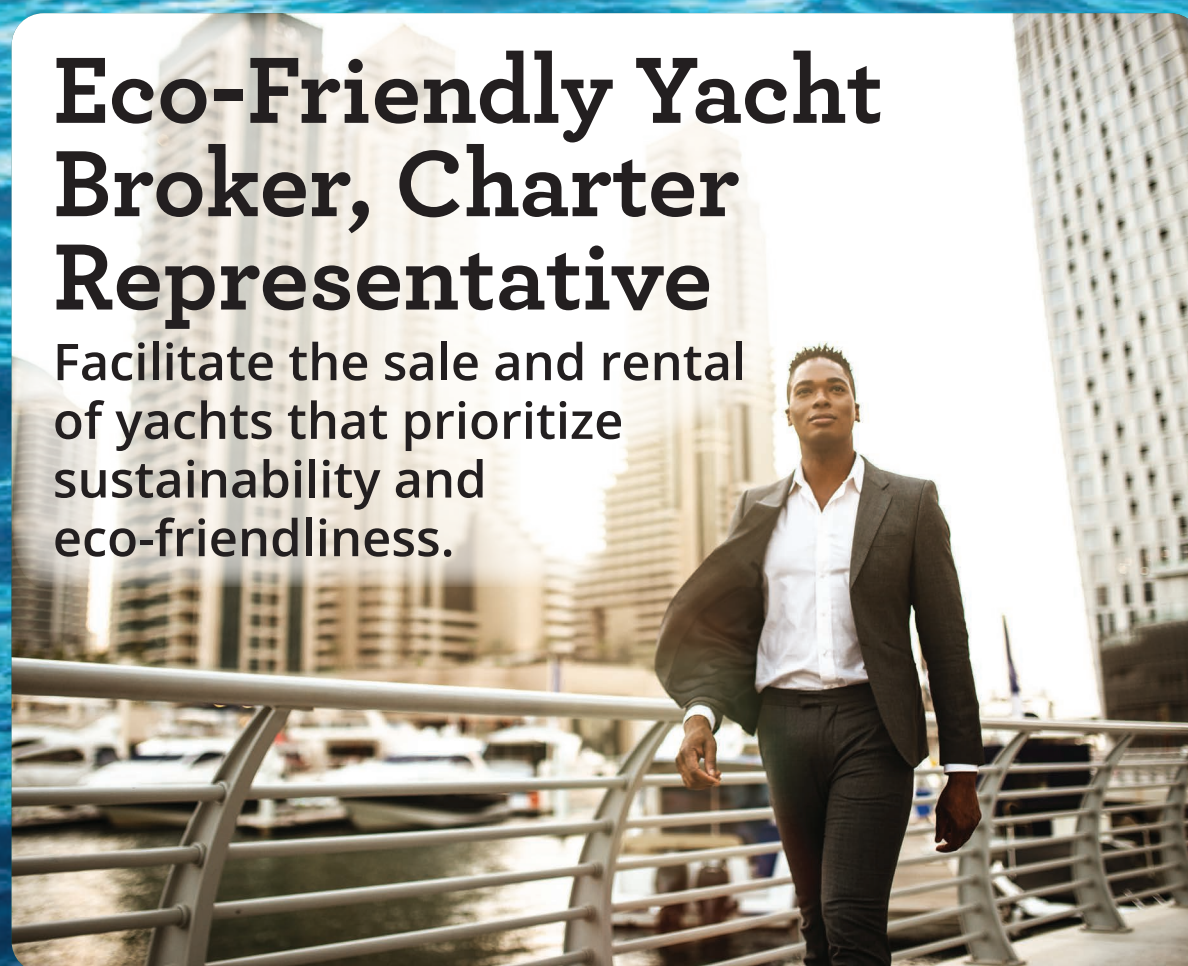
Ecotour Guide, Travel Planner
