

Versatile Valentine's Hearts!

Three fun ideas for Valentine's Day

Have students decorate the hearts and then cut them out (as squares or hearts). On the back of each one, have students write the name of a person, place, or thing they love. Then:

Use these hearts as playing pieces for a game of tic-tac-toe on a homemade gameboard.

OR

Punch holes in the hearts and string them together with yarn to hang as decoration.

OR Have students cut the three rows of images on the dotted lines, write what they love on the back, and then fold the strips on the lines to create accordion-style Valentine's Day cards.
