What is Adopt a Cow?

- An opportunity for students to get a closer look at life on a New England dairy farm through an interactive experience, including a virtual live chat with your farmer to ask questions and meet your adopted calf — participating classes will also have access to a portal where they can ask farmers questions any time!

How does Adopt a Cow work?

- In the Fall, your class will receive an introductory packet that includes:
 - Your calf's name
 - Her birthday
 - Where she lives
 - How the farmer takes care of her
 - A special treat: A printed photo of your adopted calf and official adoption certificate!
- Throughout the school year, your class will receive:
 - Progress updates to watch your calf grow
 - Photos and videos of your cow and host farm
 - Information about life on the farm
 - Free standards-based lessons and student activities that support Common Core standards
