



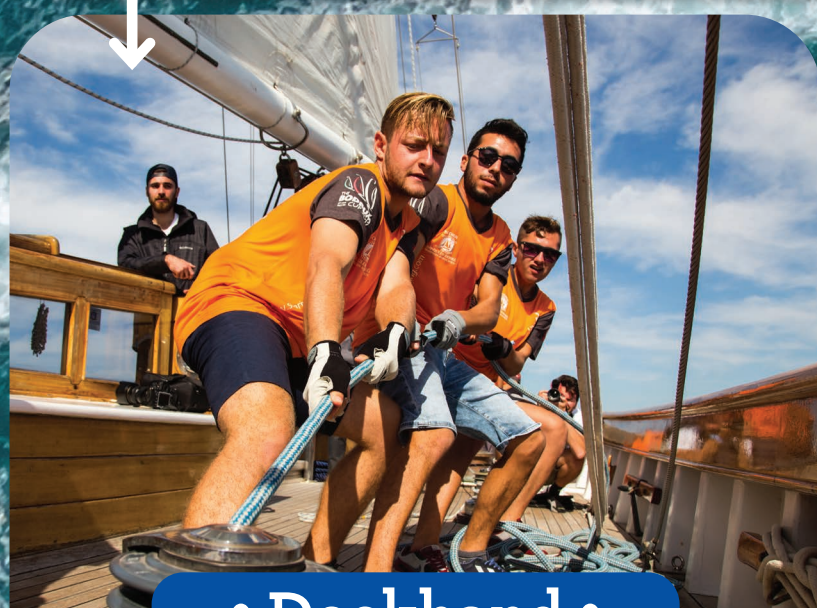
On the Job, Beyond the Docks

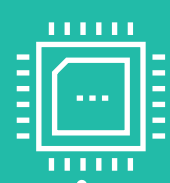

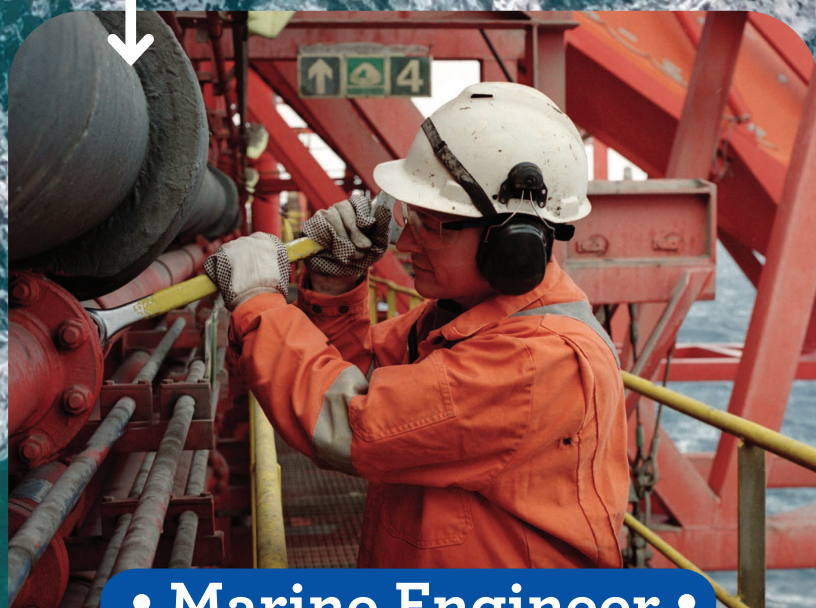


• Deckhand •

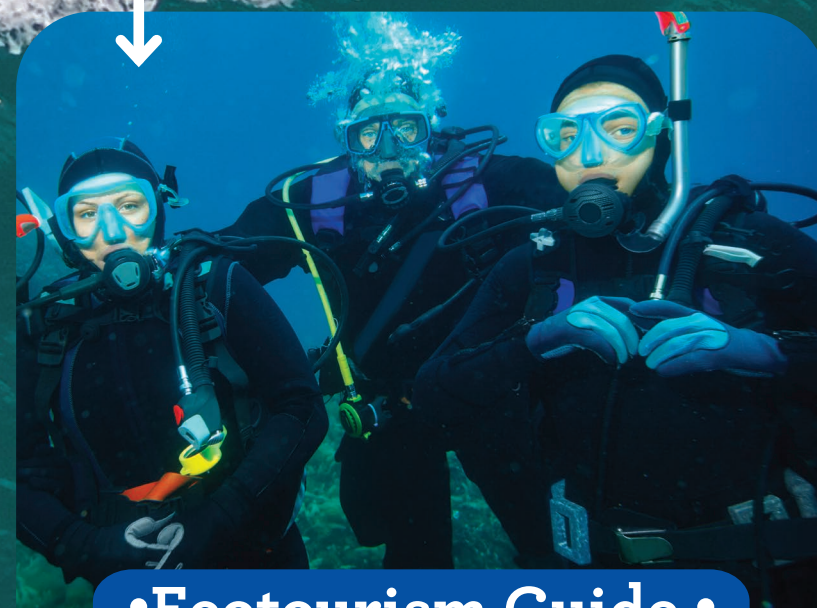


• Marine Engineer •

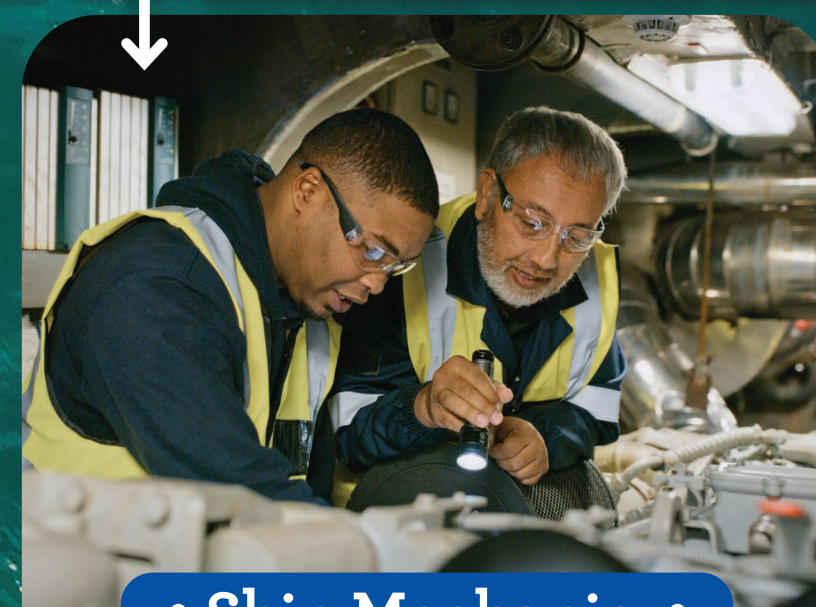


• Shipwright •

detail-oriented?

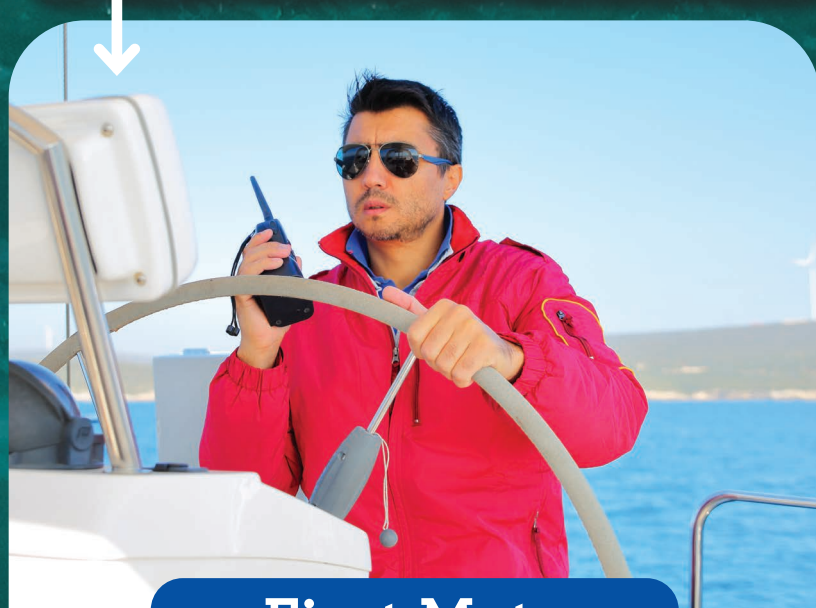


• Harbormaster •
